

## Viewing Adobe PDF Documents in iRIS on a Mac

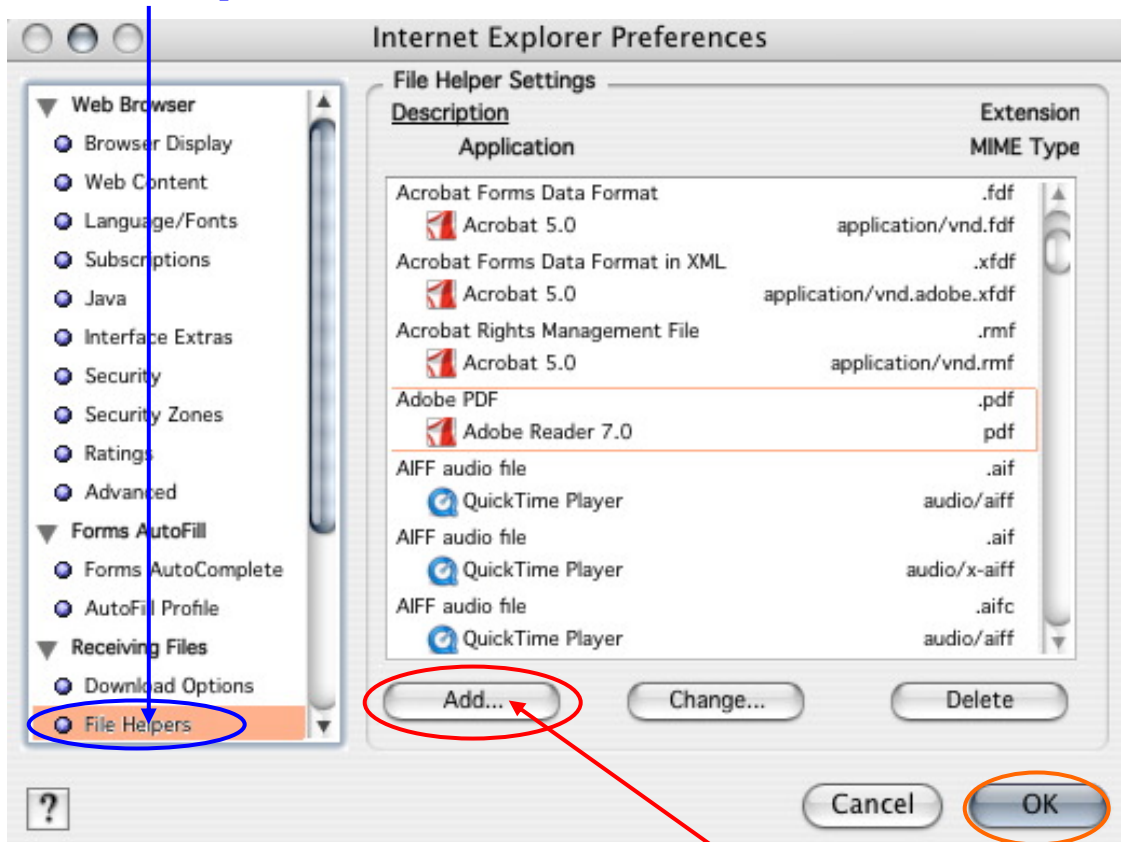

**You can view files in iRIS using Internet Explorer and Safari. The text editor which is used throughout iRIS to enter text does not work in Internet Explorer and Safari.**

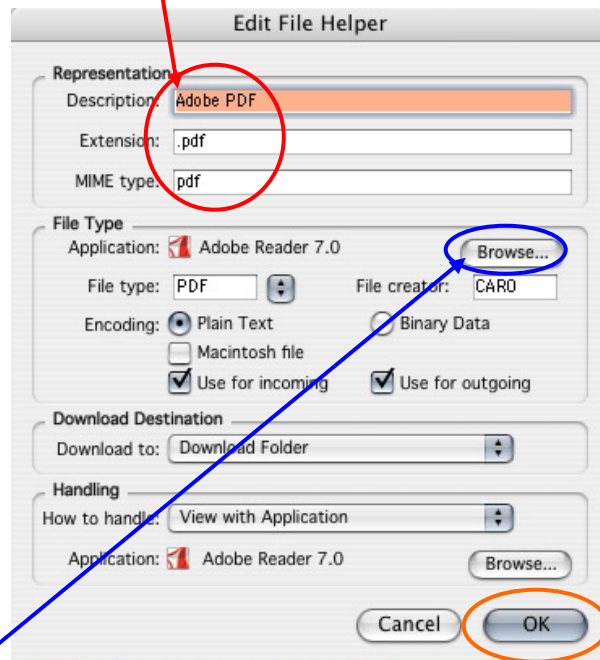
### Internet Explorer

- Using OS X Version 10.3.7 and Internet Explorer 5.2.3.
- Launch **Internet Explorer**.
- Under **Explorer** on the top left side of the menu bar open **Preferences**.
- Click on **File Helpers**.

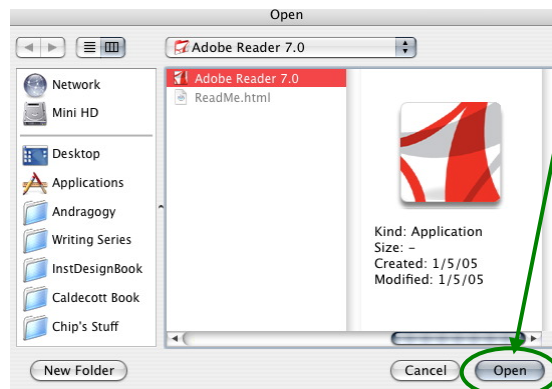


- Scroll through the list on the right side of the screen.
- If the list does **not** contain an application to open pdf files, click **Add**.

- The Edit File Helper dialog box will open.
- Type Adobe PDF for the **Description**, .pdf for the **Extension**, and pdf for the **MIME type**.



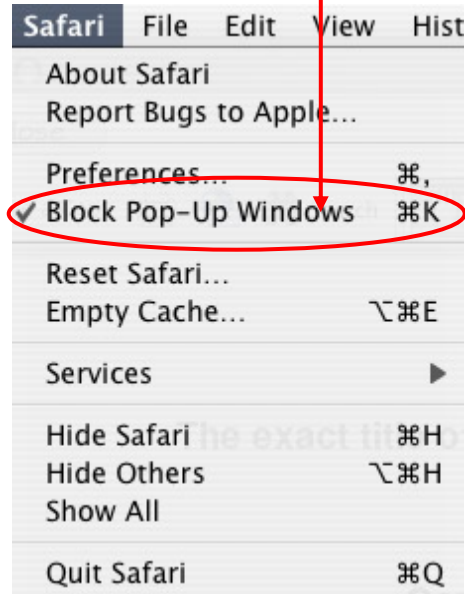
- Click **Browse**.
- Locate Adobe Reader 7.0 on your computer hard drive and click **Open**.



- Click **OK** to close the Edit File Helper dialog box.
- Click **OK** to close the Internet Explorer Helpers dialog box.
- Return to iRIS to open your pdf document.

## Safari

- Using OS X Version 10.3.7 and Safari 1.2.4.
- Launch Safari.
- Under **Safari** on the top left side of the menu bar go to **Block Pop-Up Windows**. If there is a check mark, you need to remove it by selecting **Block Pop-Up Windows** or typing Command K.



- Your screen will look like this and you will be able to open pdf files in iRIS.

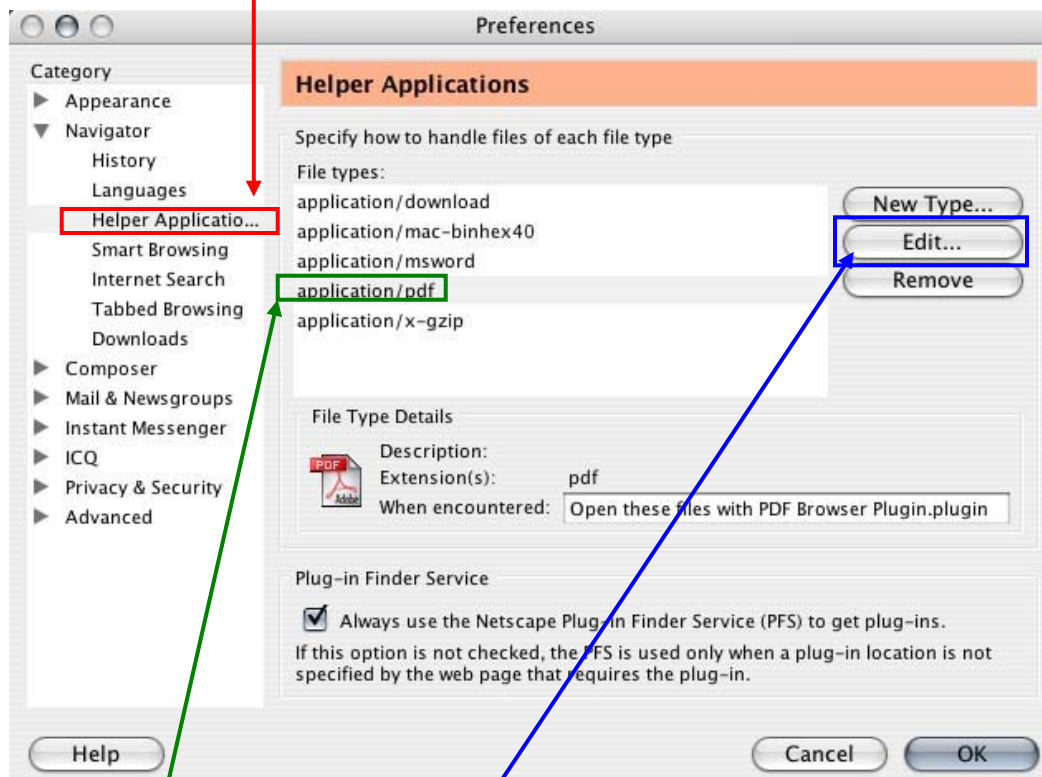


## Netscape or Mozilla

- Using OS X Version 10.3.7 and Netscape 7.2 or Mozilla 1.7.5
- Go to <http://www.schubert-it.com/> and download PDF Browser Plug-in.

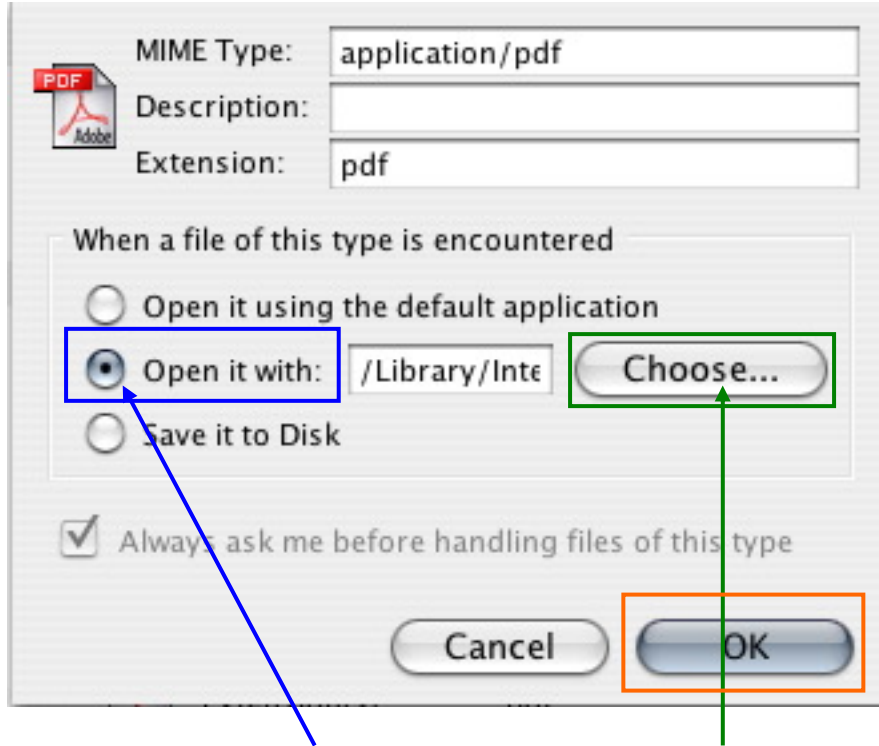
**Note: This software is free to educational institutions.**

- After you download PDF Browser Plug in click and drag the file into the Internet Plug-Ins folder inside of the Library folder on your hard drive.
- Launch Netscape or Mozilla.
- Under **Navigator** or **Mozilla** on the top left side of the menu bar open **Preferences**.
- Open **Helper Applications**.

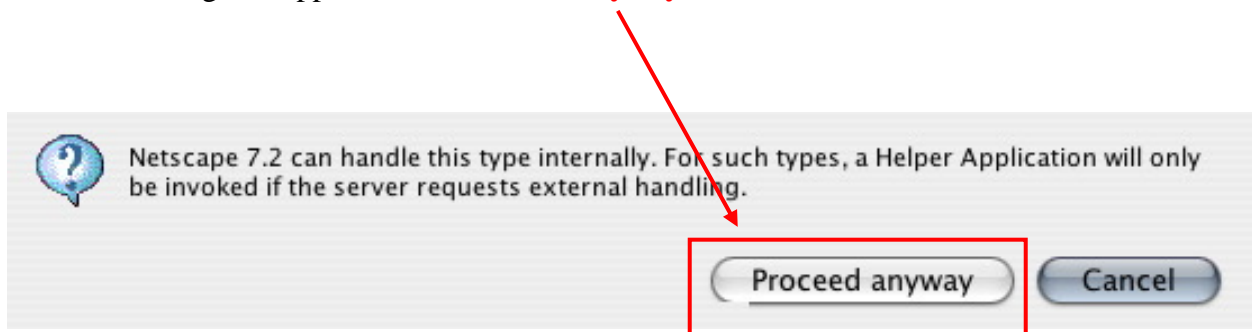


- Click **application/pdf** and then click **Edit**.

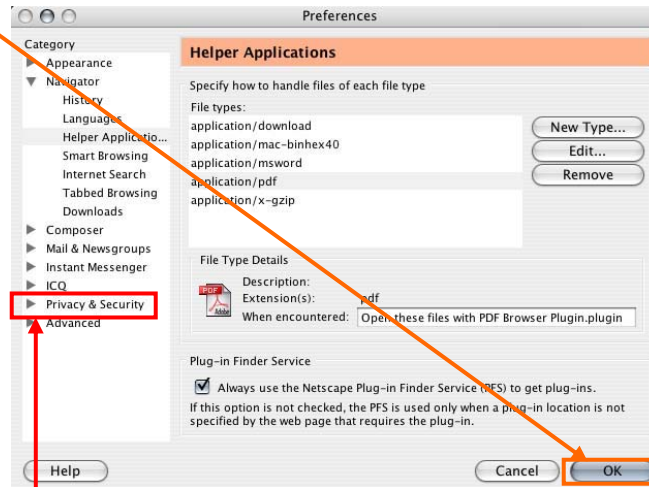
- Complete lines 1 and 3 in the dialog box as shown below.



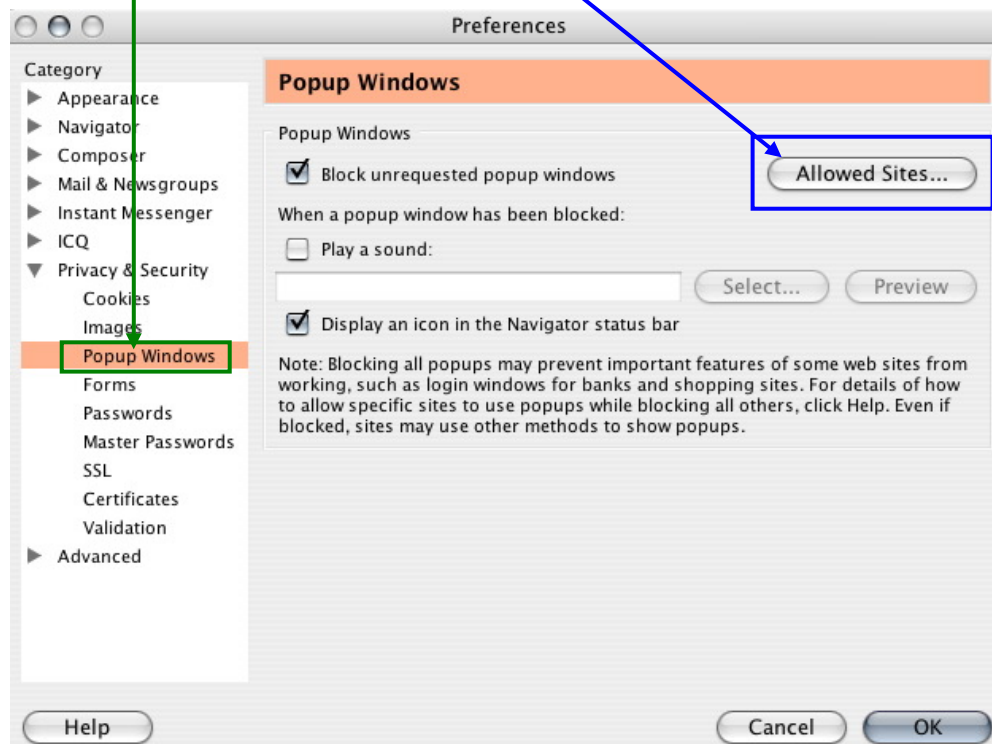
- Click the radio button in front of **Open it with:** and then click **Choose**.
- On your hard drive go to the folders Library/Internet Plug-ins and select PDF Browser Plug-in.
- Click **OK**
- If this dialog box appears click **Proceed anyway**.



- Click **OK**.



- Double-click **Privacy & Security** to reveal the options.
- Click **Popup Windows** and then click **Allowed Sites**.



- Type in the **iRIS web site address** and click **Add**.



- Click **OK**.
