

One postdoctoral position is available for January 2010 in the Department of Internal Medicine/ Division of Infectious Diseases, Laboratory for Antimicrobial Research, University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston. The candidate will participate in a NIH funded project in the field of *Enterococcus faecium* pathogenesis and Antimicrobial Resistance. The applicant should have a PhD in molecular biology with strong background in bacterial genetics, RNA analysis and protein work. The aspirant should be highly motivated, demonstrated excellence in research, communication skills and be able to conduct independent research.
