The Conference computers run Windows XP Professional[®] and have the following programs:
Microsoft Power Point 2007[®] (v2000 and v2003 presentations acceptable)
Windows Movie Maker[®] Version 2.1
Windows Media Player[®] 10.00.00.4058 (automatically updated to latest version)
QuickTime[®] 6.5.2

Please create the movie in Windows Movie Maker[®] and embed the movie into a Power Point slide presentation (for continuity during the oral presentation).

Windows Movie Maker[®] can be downloaded for free from the Microsoft web site:

CODECS allow movie files to be compressed and decompressed.

When saving the movie in Windows Movie Maker[®], select one of the following options for compatibility with the projector: (See Movie Maker[®] window examples on pages 2 and 3).

“Best Fit”

OR use the “Other Settings” drop down menu

Choose: Video for broadband (340 Kbps)

or Video for broadband (150 Kbps) – **preferred for smallest file size**

Resolution of 320 x 240 will be automatically selected

Only the following formats will be accepted for presentation:

WMV 9 (Windows Movie Maker[®])

Animated Gif

Mpeg 2.0

If the presentation is created on a MAC, please run it on a similar PC from Power Point[®] **BEFORE** the Conference. Please also have a backup copy in WMV format.

If necessary, to make sure that your movie works on the Conference computer, special arrangements may be made with the Conference to try a sample movie – of any content, 5 seconds maximum (compressed using Windows Movie Maker[®]).

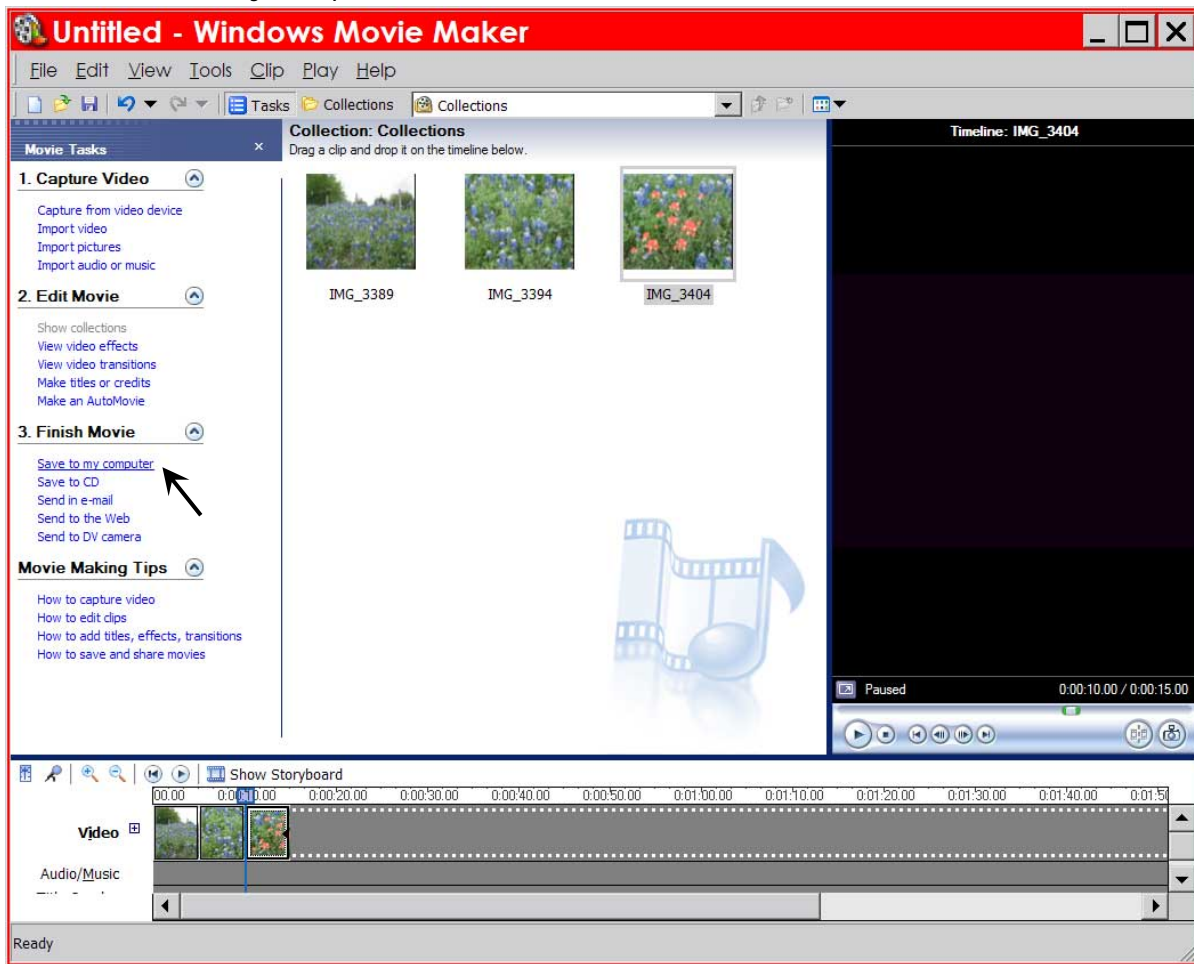
BEFORE July 1, 2009

Please check that the entire presentation (including movies) can run on a PC from Power Point[®] **BEFORE** the Conference.

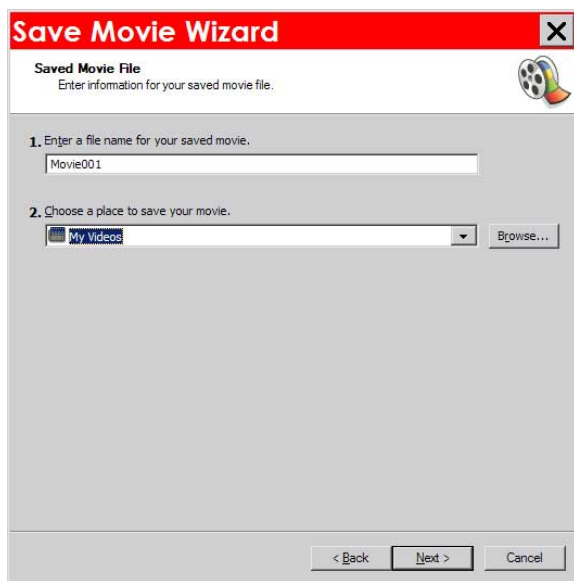

Step 1: Choose "Save to my computer" from the "Tasks" menu



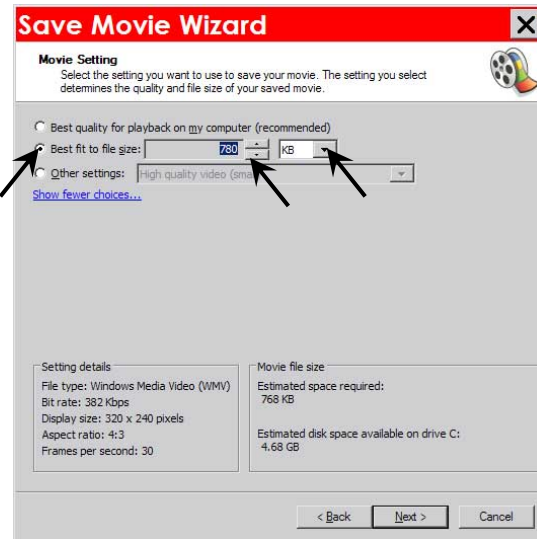
Step 2: Enter the file name and location



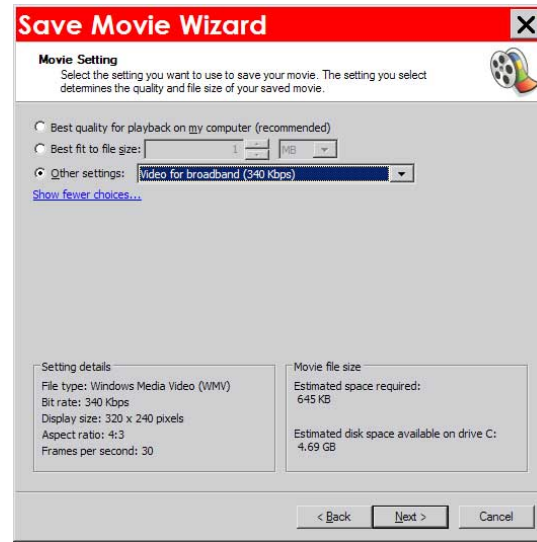
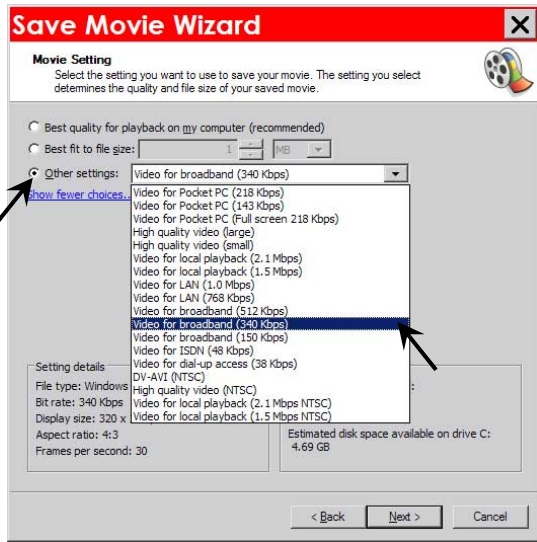
Step 3: Select "Show more choices"



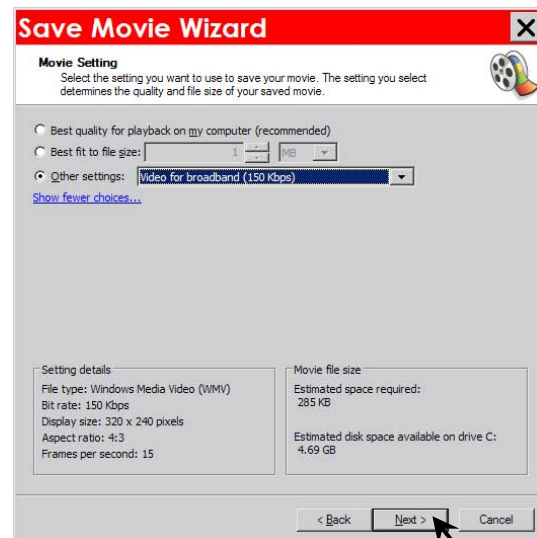
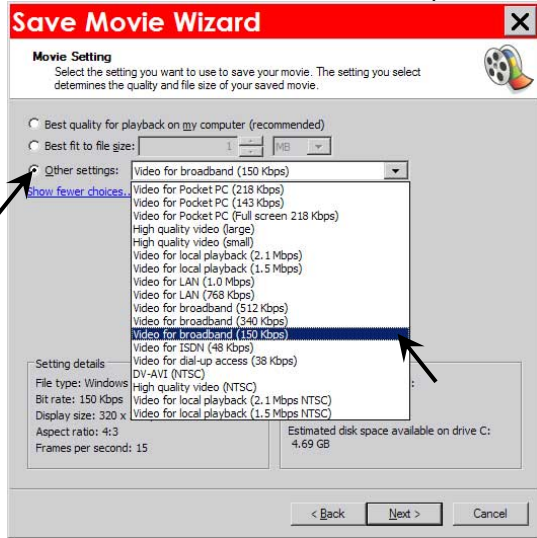
Step 4: Choose "Best fit to file size" option and adjust the file size.

or Video for broadband (150 Kbps) – **PREFERRED FOR SMALLEST FILE SIZE**
